

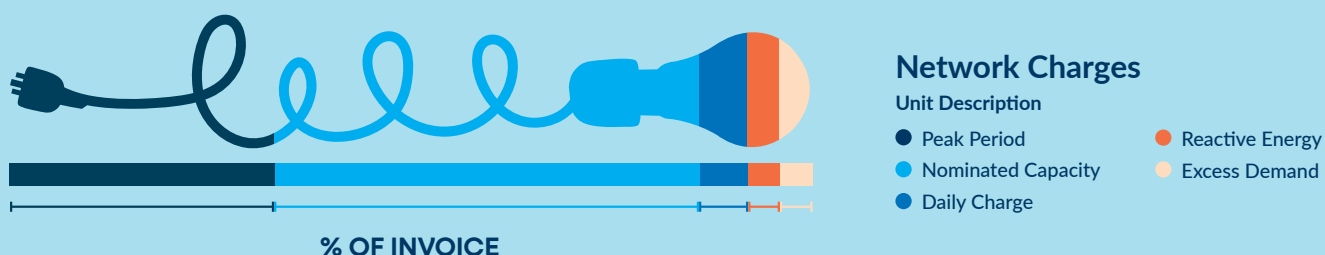

Key components of Time of Use (TOU) network charges.

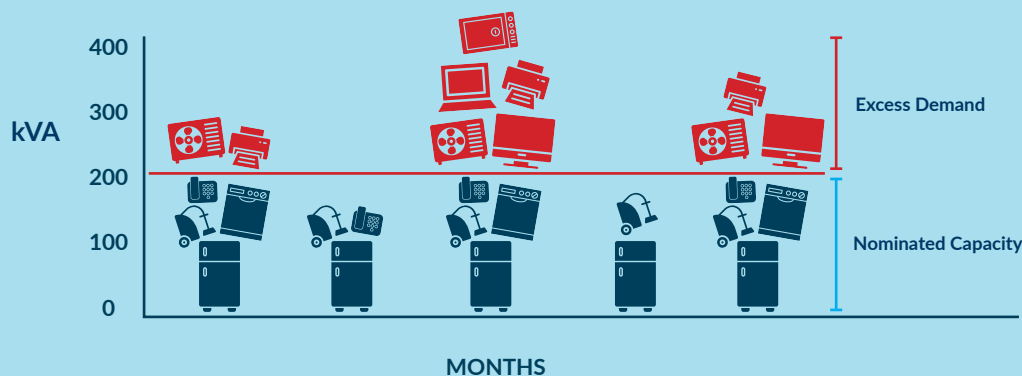
The Network Charges Breakdown on your Electricity Bill

The diagram below is an illustrative breakdown of the network charges of an electricity bill for a typical commercial consumer. However, a bill will vary slightly depending on the chosen electricity retailer and their associated discount structure, consumption levels, and the pricing category selected.



Capacity Charges

The below illustrates a typical commercial customer's usage.



Excess Demand:

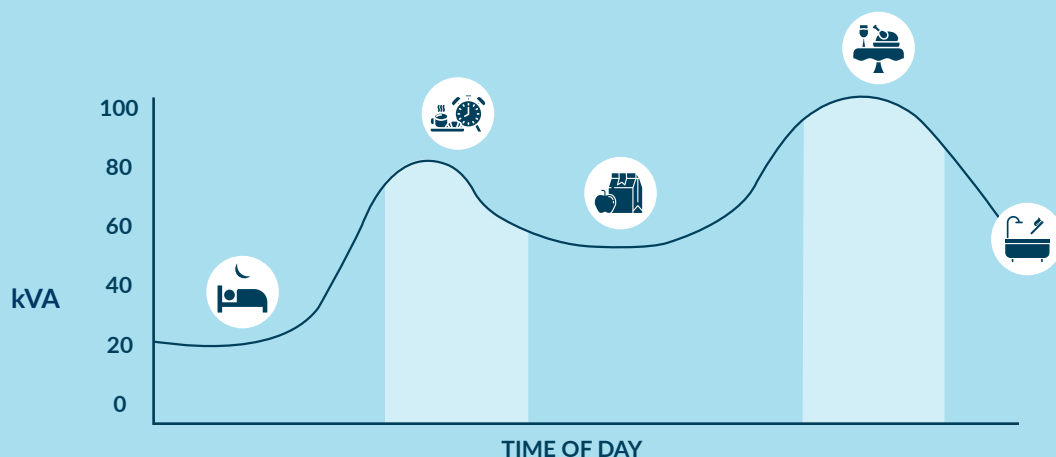
Is the rate for any electrical loading, which is in excess of the nominated capacity value. This charge is only incurred in the month/s that nominated capacity is exceeded.

Nominated Capacity:

This charge refers to a customer's nominated capacity to cover their peak loading requirements.

Peak Demand

WEL charges the average of the six highest half hour peaks recorded each month, during our published peak demand times (weekdays 7:00am-9:30am and 5:30pm-8:00pm).
